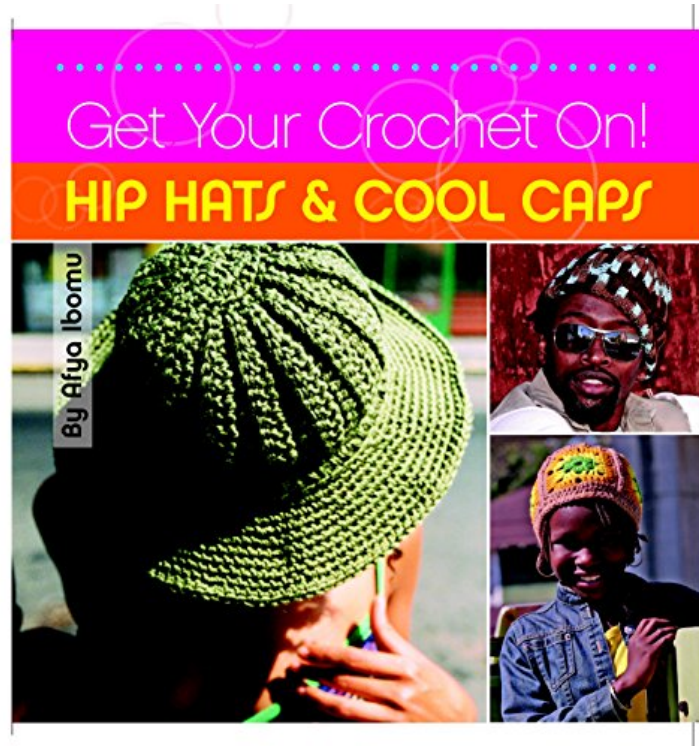

However, I have found that objects I have crocheted do not turn out to be the dimensions visually represented. I have checked, double-checked, and triple-checked my gauge. I am an intermediate skilled knitter and crocheter, so I greatly understand the dynamics of gauge. Yet, everything I have made, especially the stunning Queen head-wrap, has turned out smaller -- dramatically smaller -- than portrayed. Schematics are not provided and perhaps could greatly remedy this problem. I have made my own adjustments to get the proportions needed; but what a chore to have to make everything twice.
