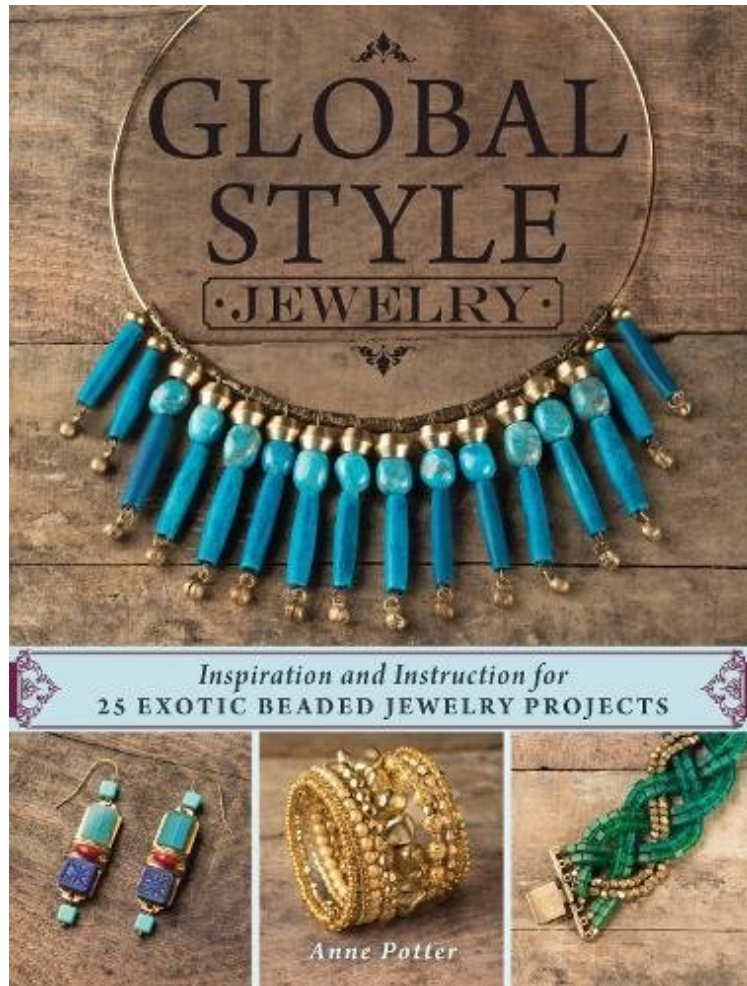

Some of the required/suggested components may not be easily available (for example, resin rose beads, huayruro seeds, celtic box clasps, etc.) and the finishing techniques may require a deeper understanding of jewelry construction techniques than presented in this book.
