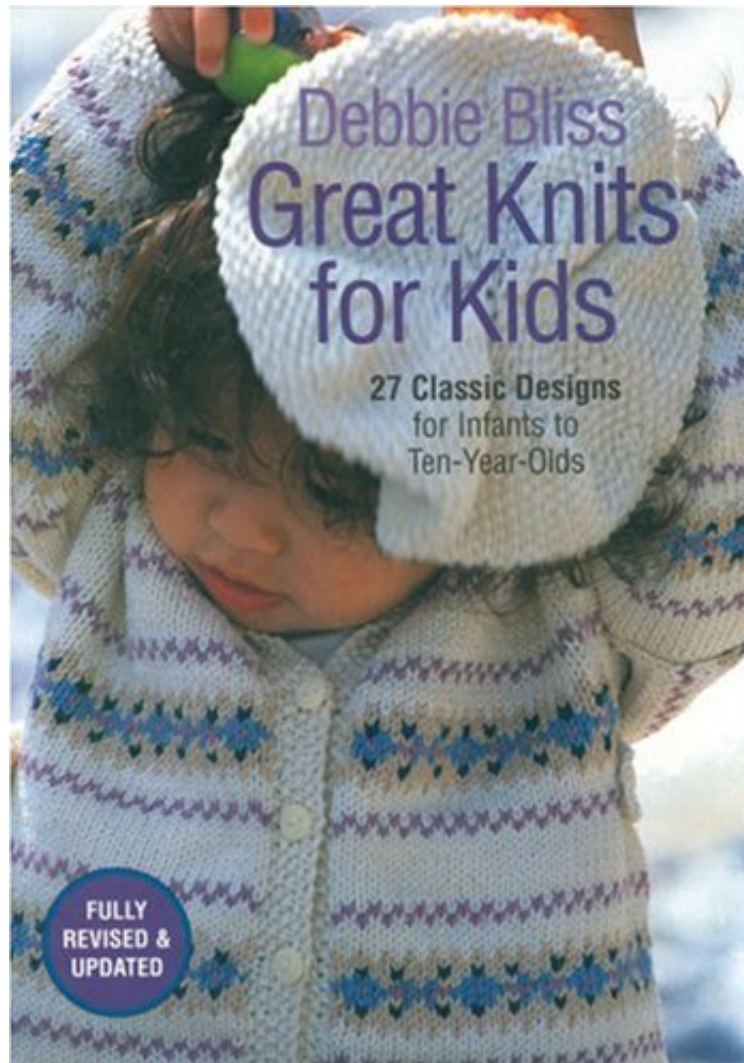

This collection of 27 sweaters for toddlers to 10-year-olds offers a mix of simple, striped, and Aran-inspired designs that will get knitters' fingers itching to begin. One reason this book is so enticing is the pictures. Charming photographs of adorable kids wrapped in sweaters make the volume worth a look even for nonknitters. Although originally published in Britain, the book provides U.S. terms and conversions in the easily understood patterns.
