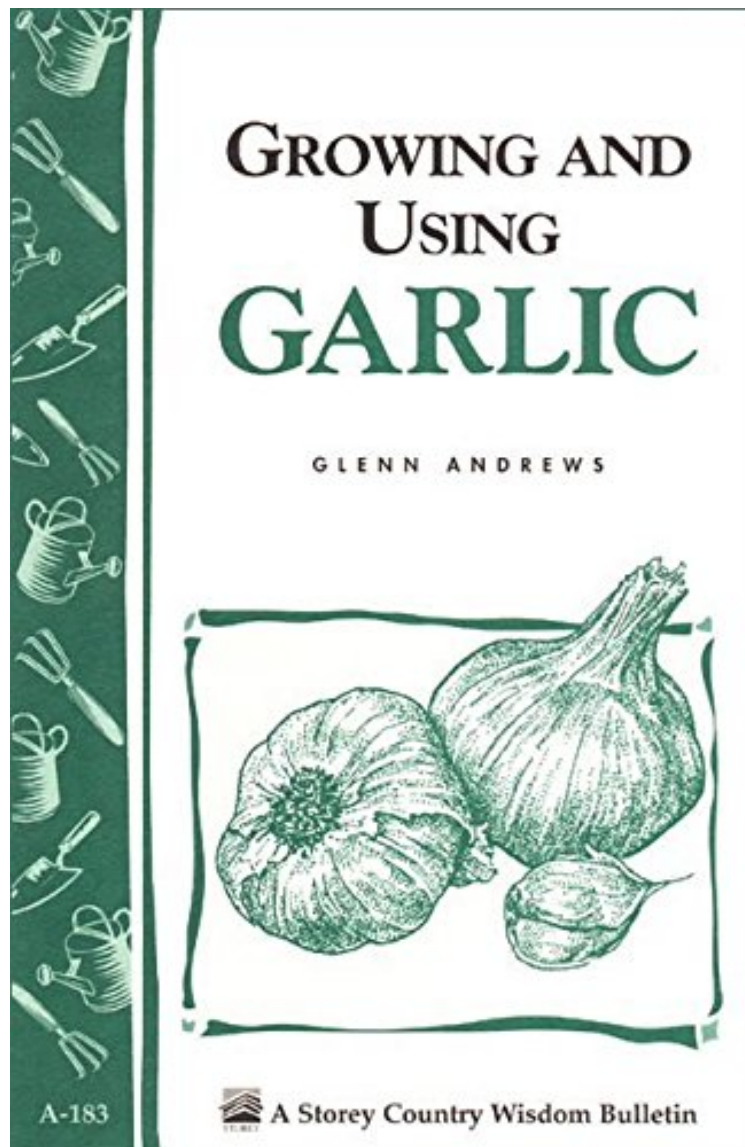

This is a nice little booklet that covers the basics very well. Clear, concise information and instruction. It is well written and does offer a pretty good amount of information. I would call this a beginners introduction to garlic. The vast majority of the booklet covers recipes using garlic. That's fine, and the ones i have tried are very good. But after reading the first half of the booklet i felt there was other information that could have been addressed instead of using so much space to cover recipes. For example, the book only covers a few types/varieties of garlic and where they are suitable to grow. It would be nice if this was expanded a bit to offer more information. I still gave it four stars because i felt it was a great starting point for me as a beginner. I have since read a couple more short books on garlic and it's many varieties.
