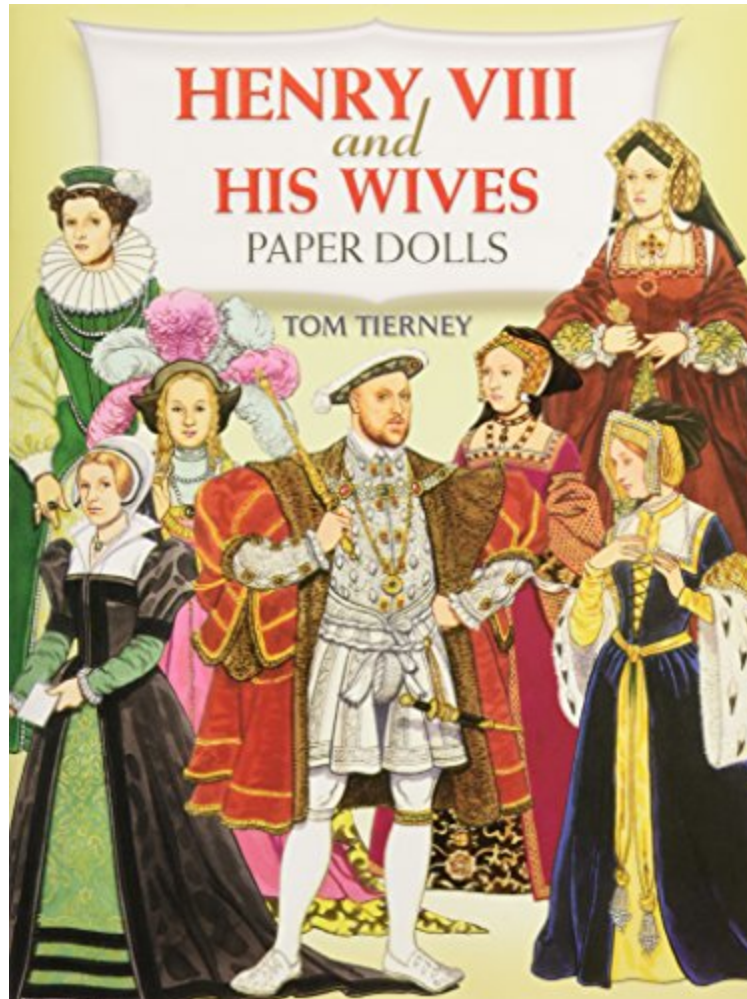

I bought this book because of my love for the Tudor period and am glad I bought it. My only complaint about is the hair color of the dolls (Anne Boleyn and Jane Seymour). Anne Boleyn was well known for her jet black hair and Jane Seymour was a blonde but in the book Anne Boleyn is depicted with red hair and Jane Seymour is given brown hair. These are minor details and stick out to me only because of my knowledge of the period. The historical facts are accurate and I would highly recommend this book to anyone interested in this fascinating dynasty.
