Its purpose was to introduce and encourage youth to tackle a comprehensive model railroad and break down the work into manageable steps anyone can follow. You need only a desire and interest plus a modicum of mechanical abilities. Do not fear; the abilities are broken down to easily accomplished steps. The illustrations and photography are very good.
