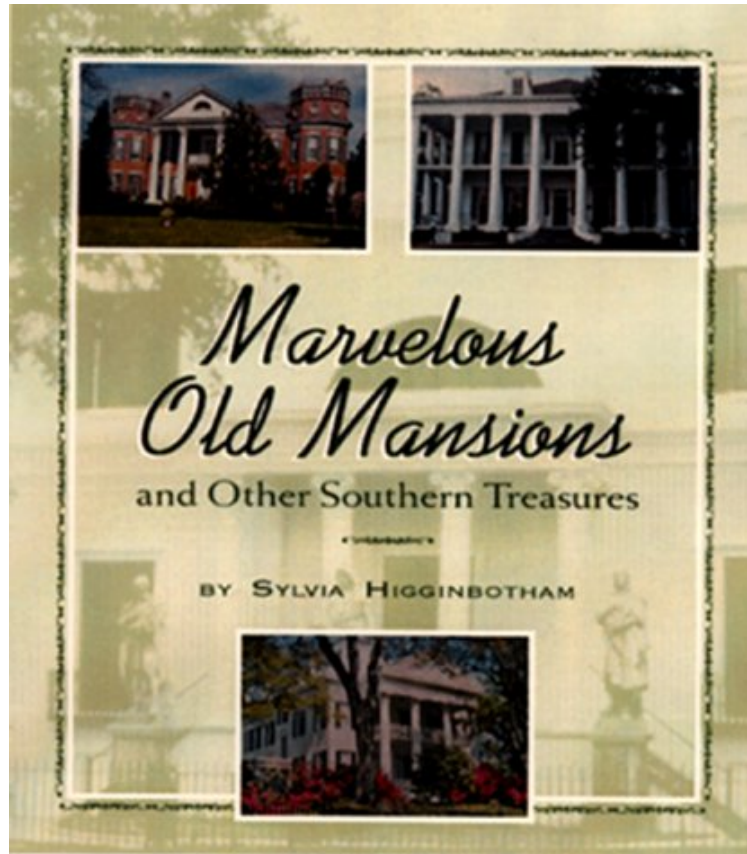

There are about 200 entries, and each includes a brief historical essay, directions, and operating hours. The area of coverage is Louisiana to Virginia, across the lower and coastal South. Texas, Arkansas, Kentucky and Maryland are not included. The book is actually a nice, selective survey that architectural historians can appreciate.
