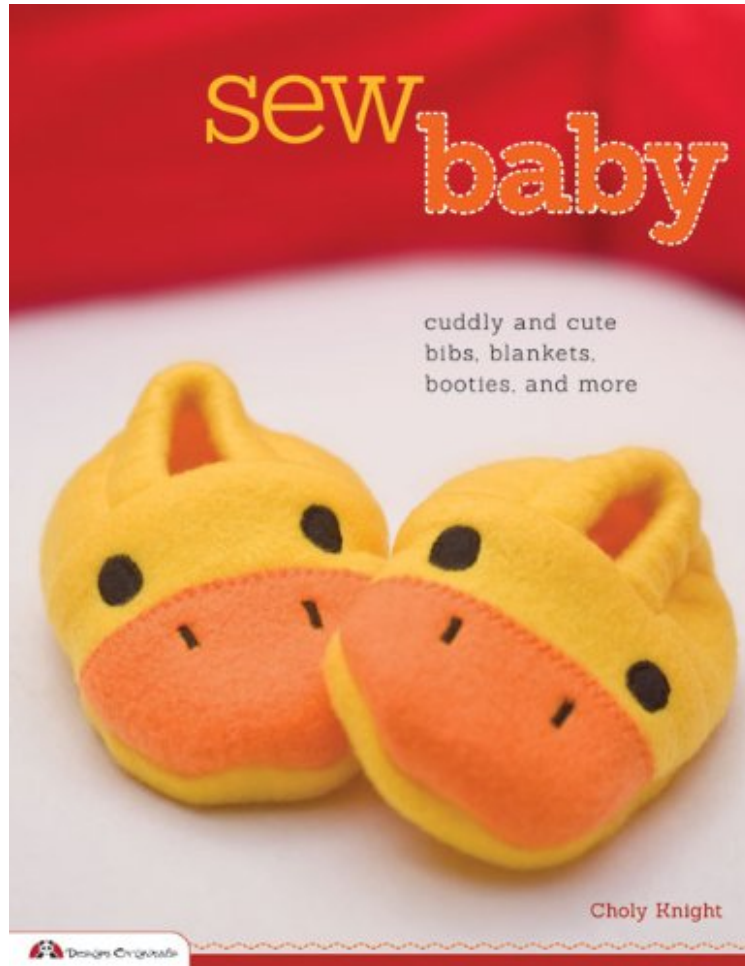

The main thing I was interested in making was the hats, but there is no indication of the sizing for any of the projects. I'm a relatively advanced sewer, so I know that I can measure off the pattern, subtracting seam allowances etc to come up with a size, but its less than ideal.Also a little disappointed that for a book that deals mostly with teensy tiny pattern pieces, they didn't print the pattern pieces to scale.
