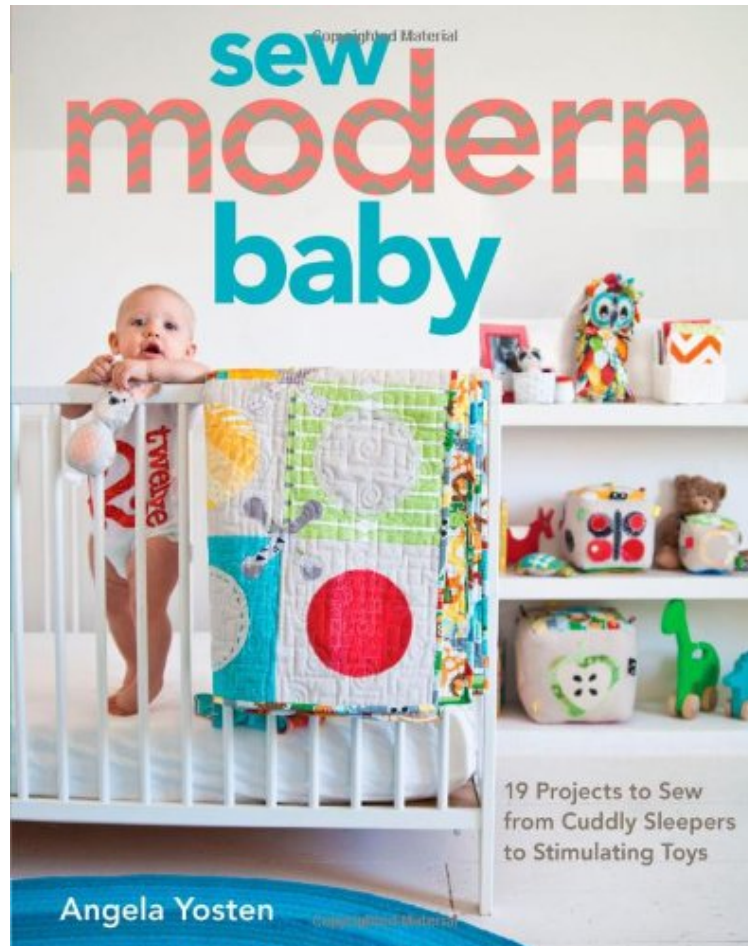

I've been sewing for many years and I found the instructions easy to follow. Also with me being such a visual learner I found the photos to illustrate the steps of the patterns really helpful. Inside the book are 19 patterns which include: -a really cool floor mat play gym -animal rattles -jumbo play blocks -carry all bag -rewards card holder (it could double for a mini brag book) -nursing cover-up -bib -burp cloth -changing pad -pacifier attached to a blanket

(biscotti)-flower hair clip-a really cute baby carrier cover-hooded panda towel-baby bunting-and my most favorite of all 3 different quilts, one of which is on the coverThere are many projects that have applique in them and I love that she used the quick fusible applique method to attach the numbers and letters to everything.
