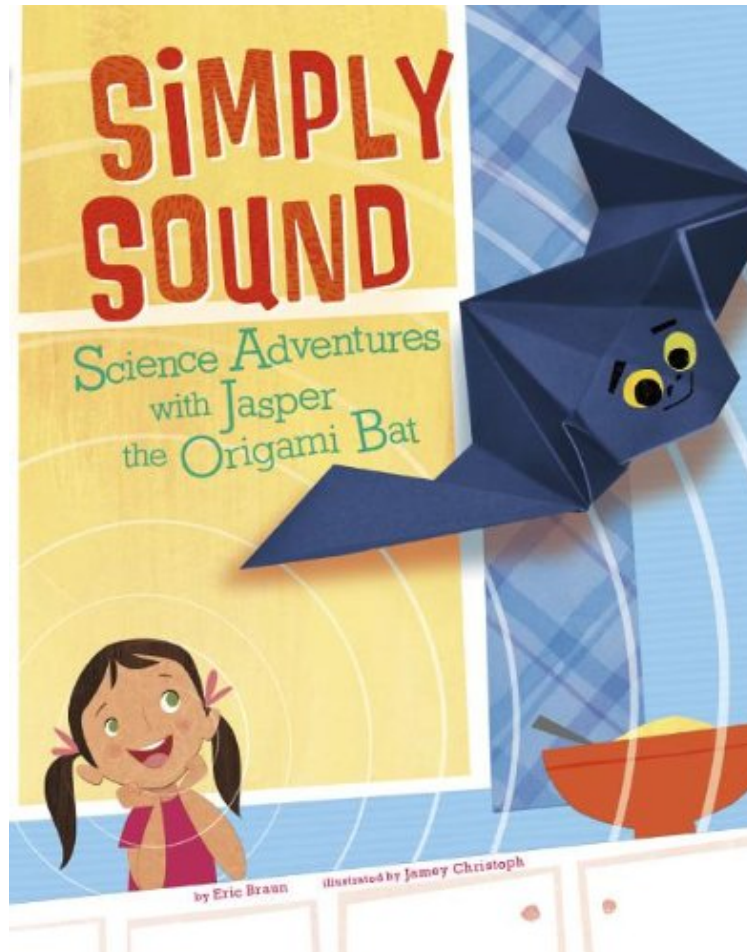

Each entry includes highlighted key terms, which are defined both in the text and in a glossary, and simple directions to make the featured origami friend. Though no one concept is explained in any real depth, each book lays out enough information for students (who may need help with terms like cochlea) to pique their curiosity and offer a general idea of how the world works.
