By Jennifer I've been making soap for almost a year so I still consider myself a newbie. That being said, this has got to be the WORST book on soap making that I've ever read. This book reads like it was written in a foreign language and then very badly translated. The soap recipes are incomplete. For example, the first recipe in Chapter 4 calls for 15 palm oil. 15 ounces? grams? There's no amount for the water in the recipe but it does say fluid ounces. Any one making soap whether newbie who has been reading reputable books and researching or a soaper who has been making soap for 20 years knows when making soap, you don't use fluid measures. You ALWAYS weigh your ingredients. This book also says to continuously stir with a wooden spoon. Lye will deteriorate a wooden spoon. Most soap makers these days use a stick blender with stainless steel parts. I could go on and on but I won't. What I will say is if you got this book for free like I did then you're not out any money and don't have to worry about refunding your money. If you did pay for this book, I'd ask for a refund and if you're contemplating getting this book. You don't want to waste your time with it. Look for a more reputable book to learn soapmaking from.
